

Overall Results
The results of treatments of in excess of 3000 horses have been extremely positive. The results from horses treated for tendon and ligament injuries have been extremely encouraging with more than 75% of treated horses returning to work at the prior level. Almost all trainers and owners of horses have reported either complete cures or a very substantial improvement in the injuries being treated.

Detailed Results

In clinical studies:

Suspensory ligament injury: 76% of horses returned to full work at the prior level. (47/62)

Joint disease: 83.4% of horses returned to work 56.7% (34/60) returned to full work at prior level 26.7% (16/60) returned to full work at a reduced level.3

Tendon Injury: 94% of horses returned to work 77% (51/66) returned to full work at prior level 17% (11/66) returned to full work at a reduced level.37
