1) Monash Immunology and Stem Cell Laboratories ('MISCL') - part of Monash University.

AVSC through its arrangements with MISCL, has been researching and developing veterinary stem cell treatments/therapies for a number of years. AVSC is developing therapies for a number of conditions in dogs, cats and horses.

MISCL is part of Monash University (Australia's largest university). MISCL is Australia's largest stem cell research group with over 100 research scientists.

2) Vet-Stem Inc of the USA

Vet-Stem is internationally the largest veterinary stem cell organization.

AVSC has a licensing/research partnership agreement with Vet-Stem Inc.

Vet-Stem (together with its other international associates), has provided stem cell treatments for in excess of 7000 dogs, cats and horses.

AVSC has an exclusive license over intellectual property (patents) covering the use of stem cells (for veterinary applications) derived from adipose tissue license covers Australia, New Zealand and parts of Asia.

AVSC believes that in regard to a number of therapeutic conditions, stem cell treatments will be more effective than traditional treatment options currently available.
